



## Travel to TTP Campus

# Current transport options to TTP Campus

## Walking

If you live in the village of Melbourn and some parts of Meldreth then walking is certainly an option. From the centre of Melbourn village heading east, the High Street becomes Cambridge Road. TTP Campus is accessed via the Melbourn Science Park on the left, towards the edge of the village. There is also a wide footpath which continues to run along the Cambridge Road, towards the local Hot Numbers Café, Dobbie's Garden Centre and the A10 towards Cambridge.

Meldreth Station is approximately a 20-minute walk to the Campus. The most direct route is via the Public Right of Way (exit via platform one) that connects to Station Road and takes you into the centre of Melbourn Village. Turn left at the traffic lights onto the High Street, continuing along this road until you reach TTP Campus on the left.

## Cycling

If you're cycling to the Campus from the direction of Cambridge and nearby villages, then the wide path which runs along the northern side of Cambridge Road is also a shared cycle path.

Meldreth station is approx. 5 minutes cycle to the site. There is a channel along the edge of the footbridge to assist dismounted cyclists. The most direct route is west along Cambridge Road/High Street and Station Road, which connects to a Public Right of Way that provides direct access to Meldreth Rail Station. An alternative cycle route is available by continuing along Station Road (turning left out of the station), over the bridge and right at the T-junction into Melbourn Village.

We have covered cycle parking secured by key fob access, a drying room for anyone needing to dry wet clothes as well as showers and lockers.

We offer a Cycle to Work Scheme through Cycle Solutions, one of the UK's leading providers. Cycle Solutions have in-house bike experts to discuss individual needs, on the phone or through the live chat function on their website. This salary sacrifice scheme benefits from Tax and NI savings as well as spreading the cost of the bike and accessories.

Melbourn Science Park also offer a regular bike clinic using Dr Bike, providing a bike safety check for free.

## Public transport

### National rail

Rail services for both Meldreth and Royston are operated by Thameslink, providing regular connections between Cambridge and London Kings Cross. Meldreth Station is approx. 20-minute walk from TTP Campus, as aforementioned. Travel times are as follows:

- **London KC to Meldreth is approx. 70 mins, trains run circa every 20-25 mins up to 9.00am.**
- **Cambridge to Meldreth is approx. 15 mins, trains run circa every 20 mins up to 9.00am.**
- **Royston to Meldreth is approx. 5 mins, trains run circa every 30 mins at peak travel times.**

We are very aware that train times and frequency are subject to changes, therefore please find up-to-date train times using the following link:

### Bus service

## By road

If you are travelling by car or motorbike, TTP Campus is on the Cambridge Road on the edge of Melbourn Village. To the north the Cambridge Road meets the A10 and the south, New Road provides a link to the A505. Both the A10 and A505 link to the M11.

We have an electric vehicle scheme if you are interested in leasing a new electric car. This salary sacrifice scheme benefits from Tax and NI savings. The chosen provider, Tusker, offer a fully inclusive package including maintenance & service, breakdown & recovery, accident management, Road Tax, and fully comprehensive insurance including up to 3 additional drivers.

We also have 34 EV charging points on the Campus and charging will be available to you at cost.
